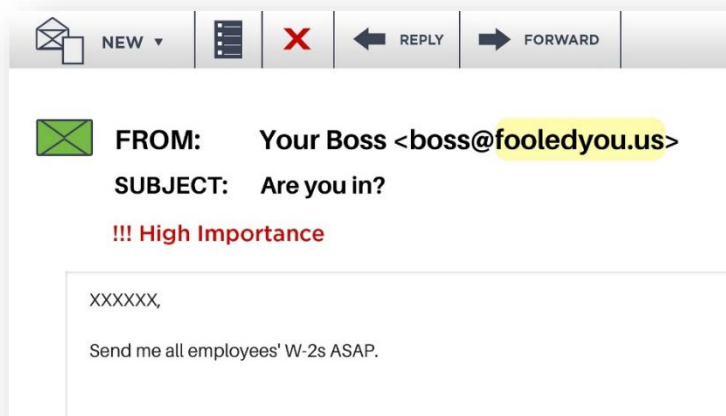
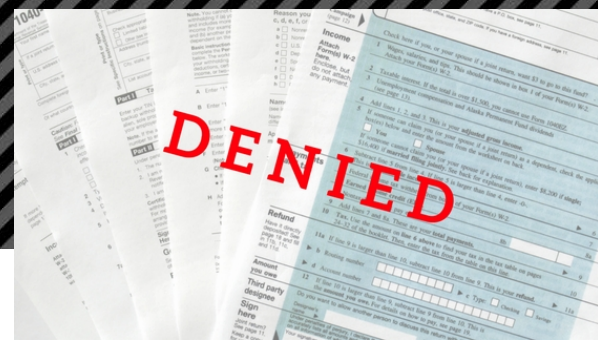


BE CYBER AWARE

TAX REFUND FRAUD

Who's getting YOUR refund? If your tax return is rejected as a duplicate, you may be a victim of tax refund fraud.



Criminals are targeting workplaces with **phishing e-mails** to steal employee W-2s and file fraudulent tax returns.

VERIFY **ALL** W-2 REQUESTS.

E-MAIL SAFETY TIP

If an unexpected e-mail requests valuable information, verify before you supply, but don't use any contact information in the e-mail. Use an existing contact method (e.g. known phone number).

When using electronic tax filing software, create a strong password and ensure all direct deposit information is accurate. File your tax return as early as possible to beat criminals to it!
